Re: Middleborough – Wood Street Force Main Replacement

Dear Mr. Peck:

Bids were received and opened for the Wood Street Force Main Replacement Project on March 10th, 2016. The bid opening was held at the office of the Department of Public Works. The following three (3) lowest bids were:

Celco Construction Corp.	\$ 394,311.95
N. Granese & Sons, Inc.	\$ 514,291.65
J. D'Amico Inc.	\$ 558,799.50

BETA Group, Inc. (BETA) has evaluated the bids to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. This determination was to be made on the basis of bid price, the bidder's capability to complete the work, and the bidder's financial condition. The details of our evaluation are as follows:

Bid Price

A bid tabulation showing the complete breakdown of each bid received is attached. As previously noted, the low bidder is Celco Construction Corp. with a bid of \$ 394,311.95. This bid compares favorably with the other bidder's prices. We are of the understanding that the Town has appropriated the necessary funds to cover all appropriate costs for this work.

Capability to Complete the Work

Celco Construction provided two (2) references of projects for similar nature and cost. Both references provided a very favorable rating including one for a project in the Town of Weymouth that is currently on going. BETA has also checked the financial status via a Dun & Bradstreet report. As a result of their proven experience, reviews and financial capacity, BETA has concluded that Celco Construction Corp. is qualified to perform this work.

Recommendation

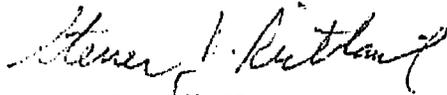
BETA has determined, based on the above criteria, that Celco Construction Corp. has submitted the lowest responsive bid. We therefore recommend that the Wood Street Force Main Replacement Project be awarded to Celco Construction Corp. in the amount of \$ 394,311.95

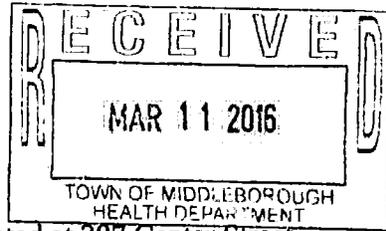

I Aaron Bernabeo Owner/Operator of Darkside Kustoms located at 387 Center Street Middleboro Ma. 02346 am writing to submit a proposal to allow my business to carry and sell vape products. We at Darkside Kustoms would like to expand our business from tattooing and piercing; which is an eighteen and over business to include the sale of vape products. Which the guidelines for the sale of tobacco products fall in line with our current regulations. This proposal is not to allow us to go ahead and sell the vape products right away but a request to see if it is allowed after the right permits are acquired.

I myself was a smoker for eighteen years and have switched to vaping which is a rapidly growing and healthier alternative to tobacco. Along with myself a lot of our clients and customers have been doing the same. I am hoping to be able to carry and sell vaping products in the shop to bring not only more business to us but to have quality product for our clients that have made the switch to vaping.

We will not be allowing any one to try or test a product before purchase. Nor will we be allowing anyone to vape inside the shop; nor groups outside of the building. We do not want to become a vape shop and have customers hanging around but to stay a tattoo and piercing establishment that carries quality high end e-liquids and vaping supplies.
