PETITION FOR JOINT OR IDENTICAL POLE LOCATIONS

September 21, 2011

To the Board of Selectmen in Middleboro, Massachusetts.

Middleboro Gas & Electric Department and Verizon New England INC request permission to locate poles, wires, cables and fixtures including the necessary anchors, guys and other such sustaining and protecting fixtures to be owned and used in common by your petitioners, along and across the following public way or ways:

Wood Street:

The petition proposes to place one (1) new stub pole 49 ½ S to be added to support pole 49 ½ when lines are reconfigured to accommodate the new feed arrangement to Ocean Spray and Northeast Refrigeration.

Wherefore they pray that after due notice and hearing as provided by law, they be granted joint or identical locations for and permission to erect and maintain poles, wires and cables, together with anchors, guys and other such sustaining and protecting fixtures as they may find necessary, said poles to be erected substantially in accordance with the plan filed herewith marked-VZ N. E. INC. No. **2011-02** dated **9/21/11**.

Also for permission to lay and maintain underground laterals cables and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as each of said petitioners may desire for distributing purposes.

Your petitioners agree to reserve space for one crossarm at a suitable point on each of said poles for the fire, police, telephone and telegraph signal wires belonging to the municipality and used by it exclusively for municipal purposes.

ORDER FOR JOINT OR IDENTICAL POLE LOCATIONS

In Board of Selectmen of the Town of Middleboro, Massachusetts,

Notice having been given and a public hearing held, as provided by law, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED;

That the Middleboro Gas & Electric Light Company and Verizon New England INC. be and they are hereby granted joint or identical locations for and permission to erect and maintain poles and their respective wires and cables to be placed thereon, together with anchors guys and other such sustaining and protecting fixtures as said Companies may deem necessary, in public way or ways hereinafter referred to, as requested in petition of said Companies date the 21st day of September 2011.

All construction under this order shall be in accordance with the following conditions: Poles shall be of sound timber and reasonably straight and shall be set substantially at the points indicated upon the plan marked- MG&E., No. 2011-02 Dated 9/21/11 -Filed with said petition. There may be attached to said poles by said VERIZON NEW ENGLAND INC. not to exceed 40 wires and 4 cables and by said Middleboro Gas & Electric not to exceed the necessary wires, cables and fixtures and all of said wires and cables shall be placed at a height of not less than 18 feet from the ground at highway crossings and not less than 16 feet from the ground elsewhere.

The following are the public ways or parts of ways along which the poles above referred to may be erected, and the number of poles which may be erected thereon under this order: -

Street name: Wood St.

Description of work: The petition proposes to place Stub pole 49 1/2 S to be added to support pole 49 1/2 when lines are reconfigured to accommodate the ne feed arrangement to Ocean Spray and Northeast Refrigeration.

Also that permission be and hereby is granted to each of said Companies to lay and maintain underground laterals, cables and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as each may desire for distributing purposes.





Subject: Permission for selected activities on and around Veterans' Day 2011

Date: October 19, 2011

This being the 150th anniversary of the start of the Civil War in 1861 and Middleborough having taken a major role in that war we will be focusing our Veterans' Day 2011 events around it.

The Middleboro Veterans' Council requests your permission for the following 4 items:

1. A parade permit for the Middleboro Veterans' Council to hold their annual Veterans' Day Parade on Friday the 11th of November 2011. It would step off from the Middleboro Town Hall parking lot at or about 10:00am. Parade participants will be asked to begin forming up at 9:30am so that Bob Lessard, our parade coordinator and his assistants, can put together the order of march. Upon the completion of the parade at or about 11:00am we will be holding the Veterans' Day Services on the portion of the Town Hall lawn nearest the Civil War Monument..

I would like to invite all the Selectmen and the town manager to participate in any or all of the Veterans' Day events. If any of you are interested in making a short speech at the ceremony, focused on the Civil War, please let me know as soon as possible so we can schedule it into the program.

The parade route for this year is as follows:

Leaving the Middleboro Town Hall parking lot by taking a right on to Union St.

Turning right on to Nickerson Ave.

Crossing South Main St. on to Webster St.

Left on to Clifford St.

Left on to Wareham St. up Centre St. to Everett Square

Left on to High St.

Left on to Pearl St.

Right on to Centre St.

Right on to South Main St.

Right on to the walkway into the Middleborough Veterans' Memorial Park

2. The Middleborough Veterans' Council would like to request the use of the Selectmen's room in the Middleborough Town Hall on Veterans' Day to have military memorabilia displayed before, during, and after our Veterans' Day activities. We would like to set up the room late in the day on Thursday the 10th of November 2011. We are hopeful that there not be any meetings scheduled in that room on Thursday evening.

3 The Middleborough Veterans' Council would like to reserve the Middleborough Town Hall auditorium on Veterans' Day first as a backup location for Veterans' Day events in case of rain, and also to use the balcony for those speaking at our Veterans' Day ceremony. Paul Provencher will be the POC for the council to get the key, open, and secure the building.

4. Simeon L. Nickerson Post 64 of the American Legion would like to request a poppy permit so they can hold their annual poppy drive running from Thursday November 3rd 2011 through Sunday November 6th 2011 plus Veterans' Day November 11th.
