Our last HHW collection of 2011 continued our record of no rain since PSC began doing our events last fall. It was a sunny, brisk day, and the event ran smoothly. Attendance was low, but a bit busier than last year. Kenny was very helpful. I misunderstood Andy's directive to have PSC take ALL paint, assumed just oil based.

It was just slow enough that the minimum charge will apply.


Count sheet and visitor forms are attached.

We had 3 Plymouth residents arrive without authorization, as the Old Colony Memorial write-up didn't mention this detail. Kenny and I agreed that since it was unlikely we'd hit the minimum, we let them through (they had small quantities).

I'm not sure if the "Small Quantity" option was selected. Over half of the loads would have fallen under this category (less than 5 gal/10 lbs). If the Small Quantity formula is applied, Middleboro's cost would have been \$2,912, rather than \$3,311. Either way, the minimum charge applies.
