



Honorable Board,

On Saturday November 6, 2011 shortly after mid-night Police Officer Nathan J. Ferbert was dispatched to check on suspicious activity on Cedar Street. A citizen had driven by and observed several people and a vehicle on this rural street and thought it was odd given the time of night so a call was made to the Police Department.

Upon arrival Officer Ferbert discovered a young man had just been stabbed and the suspect was driving away at that time. As Officer Brad Savage arrived on the scene to provide medical care, Officer Ferbert pursued this suspect vehicle. On Soule St. Officer Ferbert conducted a felony motor vehicle stop and arrested the suspect. This suspect would be later charged with 2nd degree Murder.

Officer Ferbert's, quick, decisive and brave actions, while alone, resulted in the rapid apprehension of this suspect. He is a credit to the Town of Middleborough Police Department and should be commended by the appointing authority for his actions.
