Dear Selectman:

I am requesting that the Board of Selectman consider changing the appointment of Constables from one to three years.


Many of the surrounding towns in Massachusetts, including Lakeville, East Bridgewater & Carver, to name a few, appoint the Constables for three years. Per Massachusetts law, M.G.L. Chapter 41, § 91A – Appointment in towns: a town or city may appoint constables for up to three years.

In doing so, this would be a saving in time for the Board of Selectmen's administrative staff to focus on other responsibilities. Also, it would free the Board of Selectman to hear other issues rather than discussing the appointments of the Constables on a yearly basis.

Appointing the Constables for three years does not take away the authority of the Board of Selectmen over the Constables. If there is an issue with a Constable, the Board of Selectmen can still reprimand this Constable or revoke his/her appointment.




