Press Release

January 31, 2013

At approximately 5:30pm on January 30, 2013, the Plymouth Police Department located and took possession of the Smith & Wesson .357 revolver left unattended in the Wareham Courthouse by Captain John Rogers Jr. on Monday (January 28, 2013). The Wareham Police Department led the investigation with the assistance of Plymouth Police Detectives. The Massachusetts State Police, the FBI, as well as several other local Police Departments assisted in the search for this weapon.

Detectives from the Middleborough Police Department were instrumental in the development of information leading to the location of the revolver. The intelligence gathered by the Middleborough and Plymouth Police Detectives led to the successful recovery of the weapon. All Patrol Officers as well as Detectives working this case should be commended for their commitment and diligence displayed throughout the search. The Plymouth Police Department is grateful for the efforts of these agencies.
