
We look forward to a great race day and sharing the beauty of Middleborough with our athletes. Please don't hesitate to contact me with any questions.

The local Fire Department must be notified of the detour to ensure that measures will be taken to minimize disruption to the Fire Department's emergency service during the event. The Grantee(s) must also notify local media (newspapers, radio) of this proposed event.

The following signatures are required prior to the issuance of the Permit. All officials listed below shall assume all responsibility and liability for all activity associated under their jurisdiction.
