The St Vincent de Paul Food Pantry is seeking approval to conduct a charity race/walk as a fund raiser to the benefit poor of our community.

We are considering a 5K race to be held in conjunction with a nationwide effort sponsored by the National St Vincent de Paul Society for the poor. All funds raised by this event would stay in our local community.


Our plan is to hold this race/walk at 10:00 A.M. on September 29<sup>th</sup>, 2012. We are seeking permission to stage this event from the John T. Nichols Middle School at 112 Tiger Way. This proposal has been presented to the office of the superintendent of schools which is checking upon the school's availability; the decision is pending. We acknowledge there would be a fee to have the school open for restroom purposes.

I have enclosed a map depicting the proposed route the participants would follow, essentially down Tiger Way, up Wood Street, onto Sachem St, onto Wareham St and back to Wood Street and the school.

The race portion would be a timed event and the walk segment would be a leisurely stroll for the majority of our participants. Since this is our initial attempt at this particular type of fund raiser we do not anticipate a large turnout the first year.

I have presented this plan to the police department who suggested this request be approved with a letter from the office of the selectmen to ensure all necessary bases have been covered.






