The St Vincent de Paul Food Pantry is seeking approval to conduct a charity race/walk fund raiser. All funds raised by this event will remain in our local community and benefit the many needy families living here.


Our intention is to hold this race/walk at 10:00 A.M. on Sunday, September 27th, 2015. We are seeking permission to stage this event from the John T. Nichols Middle School at 112 Tiger Way. This proposal has been presented to the office of the superintendent of schools who has approved the use of the school and reserved this date for us. We acknowledge there will be the usual and customary fees to have the school open for restroom purposes, staff considerations, parking lots, etc. and we are in contact with them regarding the insurance liability as we have the past few years.

I have enclosed a map depicting the proposed route the participants would follow; essentially proceeding down Tiger Way, up Wood Street, onto Sachem Street, onto Wareham Street and back to Wood Street and return to the Nichols Middle School.

The race portion would be an officially timed event. The walk segment would be a relatively leisurely stroll for the majority of our walking participants. This is our fourth attempt at this particular type of fund raiser, last year we had approximately 445 participants. We are hoping for an equal or slightly larger turnout for this year, weather permitting.

This is the same plan which was submitted and approved by the Fire department, the Police department and the Board of Selectmen for the past three years.



I am writing to let you know the 9th annual Patriot Half triathlon is scheduled for Saturday, June 20. The Patriot Half is based at Cathedral Camp in East Freetown and involves athletes swimming then biking and then running.

As in the past, athletes will utilize selected roads in Middleborough as part of the bike segment of this event.
