






Admission is free.



Assessing the health of the Taunton River and its tributaries is a vital need and a critically important part of TRWA's work. The training session will be conducted by Alex Houtzager, Chair of TRWA's Water Quality Committee. Admission is free of charge. Coffee and doughnuts will be provided.


No prior experience is necessary. However, you must be willing to commit about two hours each month to do this testing.



Testing is done on the 2nd Tuesday morning of each month. 2015 water testing will begin on April 14. Samples are taken to the Taunton Wastewater Treatment Plant for analysis. At the training session, we will verify the sampling

sites to be used for testing.

On sampling days, we go out to testing sites at 6 a.m. and deliver water samples to the laboratory at the Wastewater Treatment Plant by 8. Your participation will bolster TRWA's efforts to track water quality at sites along the Taunton River and several tributaries.



Volunteers who sampled sites in previous years are also encouraged to attend this training session for a "refresher" course.

This is a great opportunity to learn techniques of testing pollutant levels in our waterways and to enjoy dawn with the inhabitants of our rivers and streams.


