RE: Rt. 44 Bridge Over Rt. I-495



As you are aware, in Middleboro there is a sewer force main pipe suspended under the Rt. 44 Bridge that spans Rt. I-495. This pipe services the private businesses located on the westerly side of Rt. I-495. There is a pump station at the former Crossroads RV Center, now the Metro Volkswagen dealership.

Approximately one year ago there was a sewer blockage in the pipe over the highway that resulted in bursting of the pipe. There was damage to the pipe over both the northbound and southbound lanes. The pipe has not been repaired, and the force main is no longer being used.

The private businesses have proposed to re-route their sewer outlet pipe to Clayton Street to the north of Rt. 44. It will connect to an existing gravity sewer main that is located under Rt. I-495 (to the north of Rt. 44).

I am requesting that you make a determination as to whether the existing damaged pipe over Rt. I-495 should be removed. The private businesses have agreed to assume this expense, if necessary.
