Subject: Important Funding Issue

Hello All,

As you know, our coalition is funded by the Drug Free Communities Program. We received the grant in the fall of 2007 and we will receive funding until September, 2012.

We are eligible to apply for an additional 5 years of this funding after 2012, but this funding has been cut drastically. If the current budget is approved, only seven additional communities nationwide will receive Drug Free Communities Funding. This includes all of the communities who will be applying for their years 6-10 funding as well as communities applying for funding for the first time.

BACKGROUND

The House recently passed its version of the FY 2011 Continuing Resolution (CR) to fund the federal government for the rest of this fiscal year. The House-passed CR cuts the Drug Free Communities (DFC) program by \$9.5 million, from \$95 million to \$85.5 million. The Senate has not yet passed its version of the CR, so there is still time to weigh in to try to get this money restored.

A funding level of \$85.5 million would support only seven new grants nationwide. Funding for the program in the FY 2011 CR needs to be restored to the FY 2010 appropriated level of \$95 million to allow at least 75 new grants to be awarded.

It is critical that the field work to ensure that funding for the DFC program is restored in the FY 2011 CR.

Note: the RFA for the DFC program that was recently released will not be affected by the CR as it will use already appropriated (FY 2010) funds to support the approximately 75 new grants.

WHAT YOU CAN DO

Both the House and the Senate need to hear from the field en masse that funding for the DFC program must be restored in the FY 2011 CR to ensure the DFC program's continued growth. Please ask your members of Congress to support the FY 2010 appropriated level of \$95 million for the DFC program in the FY 2011 CR. Using CADCA's CapWiz system, fax the sample letter to the members of your congressional delegation to ask them to fund the DFC program at a level of \$95 million for FY 2011. **YOUR FAX IS CRITICAL.** The more letters your members of Congress receive on this issue, the more likely they are to reject the House-passed level of \$85.5 million for the DFC program.

TIMING

URGENT ACTION REQUIRED - IMMEDIATE. CADCA will continue to monitor the DFC program as the appropriations process moves forward and will alert you when further action must be taken.


