Emergency Management Directors:

As you know, MEMA has been working with many of you on assessing damages from two recent blizzards/coastal storms for the purpose of determining whether any areas of the state are eligible for disaster assistance under Major Disaster Declarations. This email is intended to provide you an update on the assessment processes.

February 8-9, 2013 Blizzard: MEMA has completed our review of the FEMA Preliminary Damage Assessments (PDAs) conducted for the February Blizzard and we are now working with the Executive Office of Public Safety and Security, and the Governor's Office, to craft an official request for a Major Disaster Declaration. At this point we are optimistic that we have met thresholds to request a Major Disaster Declaration for Public Assistance and Snow Assistance and we anticipate that the Governor will file his request on or before the deadline (April 11, 2013). We will update you again as soon as the Governor's files his request.

March 6-9, 2013 Coastal Storm: MEMA has completed the Initial Damage Assessment process to determine the extent of damage associated with the March 6-9 Coastal Storm. Despite our best efforts to account for all damages, we fall far short of meeting the statewide threshold of \$8.9 million. As such, we will not request FEMA PDAs as we are ineligible to seek a major disaster declaration for this storm.


