
Dear Board Members,

The Town of Middleborough EMS Committee has been informed by Paul Girard (Girard & Associates) that AMR (American Medical Response) has not submitted all their third quarter run reports or any of their fourth quarter run reports to his company. Section H of AMR's contract with the Town of Middleborough requires that AMR submit any and all Town of Middleborough run reports to Girard & Associates to be audited for protocol deviations.

After Girard & Associates audits the reports, they are forwarded to the EMS Committee and Fire Chief for review. Any protocol deviation infractions rated as having medium or high risk of an adverse patient outcome are then discussed with AMR. AMR is then given the opportunity to investigate the protocol deviation and report back to the committee as to what corrective measures were taken.

There are no time requirements for submittal or any provisions for failure to submit the run reports in the present contract. Whereas AMR's contract expires on June 30th this year the EMS Committee, at their last meeting, voted to request the Board to withhold AMR's May and June payments until they have submitted all the required run reports. When AMR meets the requirements of the contract, the Committee will then notify the Board and request that the Board release the payments.
