Upon motion by Selectman Dalpe and seconded by Selectman McKinnon, Board voted unanimously to approve the Next Sun PILOT Agreement for 154 Purchase Street, as presented.

In response to request by Selectman Knowlton, Town Manager requested Barbara Erickson address the Board to give overview of these PILOT Agreements.

Upon motion by Selectman Dalpe and seconded by Selectman McKinnon, Board voted unanimously to approve the Next Sun PILOT Agreement for 17 Jericho Road, as presented.

Upon motion by Selectman Dalpe and seconded by Selectman McKinnon, Board voted unanimously to approve the Next Sun PILOT Agreement for Taunton Street, as presented.

Assistant to the Town Manager Evan Melillo addressed the Board to review proposed Town Facility & Grounds Use form for Town owned buildings. Town Counsel addressed the Board to clarify the anti-aid amendment. Discussion ensued. Town Manager is to ask the Town's insurance company about liability insurance coverage by renters/users of Town property. Upon motion by Selectman McKinnon and seconded by Selectman Dalpe, Board voted unanimously to set a \$5 fee per 8 hour use for residents and \$20 fee per 8 hour use for non-residents for use of Town Hall outside grounds.

Upon motion by Selectman Dalpe and seconded by Selectman McKinnon, Board voted unanimously to not meet on December 28, 2015 or January 1, 2016 with the understanding that it will meet, should the need arise, on these dates or another date during those weeks, contingent upon being able to meet the requirements of the Open Meeting Law relative to posting.

HEARINGS, MEETINGS, LICENSES

Town Counsel addressed Board to discuss 25 Granite Street Affordable Housing. Upon motion by Selectman McKinnon and seconded by Selectman Dalpe, Board voted unanimously not to accept the \$40,000 proffer.
