MINUTES

Upon motion by Selectman Dalpe and seconded by Selectman McKinnon, Board voted to approve 1/29/15 regular meeting minutes. Selectman Knowlton abstained.

Upon motion by Selectman Dalpe and seconded by Selectman McKinnon, Board voted unanimously to approve 2/12/15 regular meeting minutes.

Upon motion by Selectman Dalpe and seconded by Selectman McKinnon, Board voted unanimously to approve 2/23/15 regular meeting minutes.

WARRANTS

Upon motion by Selectman Dalpe and seconded by Selectman McKinnon, Board voted unanimously to authorize the Chairman, or his designee, to sign Warrants for week ending 3/7/15.

NEW BUSINESS

Upon motion by Selectman Dalpe and seconded by Selectman McKinnon, Board voted unanimously to approve a One-day Beer & Wine liquor license for The Bartending Service of N.E. for 3/27/15 from 7 PM to 10 PM for the Library Sock Hop to be held at the Library, 102 North Main Street.

Upon motion by Selectman Dalpe and seconded by Selectman McKinnon, Board voted unanimously to sign the warrant for the Annual Town Election of April 4, 2015.

Upon motion by Selectman Stewart and seconded by Selectman McKinnon, Board voted unanimously to approve the 2nd Annual Herring Festival to be held at the Oliver Mill Park, with parking at the KOA campground, on Saturday, April 11th and Sunday April 12th, 2015 from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Motion made by Selectman Stewart and seconded by Selectman McKinnon, to approve request by the Middleborough Farmer's Market to hang a banner inside the Town Hall annex (former Eastern

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Bank building space) window along Main and Centre Streets from 4/11/15 through 10/31/15 announcing that the Market will be located at Oliver Mill Park, Route 44 East, subject to the removal of the banner from the building should it be leased and that enough room is available with the banner presently hanging. Patti Zimmerman addressed the Board and announced that the Farmer's Market will be holding a Market on Saturdays on the Town Hall lawn and asked if they could have an advertising sign at the Oliver Mill Herring Run. Karen Blair addressed the Board and agreed that there is room for two Farmer's Markets in Town, however, the official Middleborough Farmer's Market is running under a 501C3 through the Middleborough Blues Festival. She feels that it will confuse people to have a sign on the Town Hall lawn reading that the Farmer's Market has moved. Motion made by Selectman McKinnon and seconded by Selectman Knowlton to amend vote to include allowing signs at both locations. The Park's department should be asked permission to put a sign at Oliver Mill. Town Manager's office has authority over signs on the Town Hall lawn. Board voted unanimously on the amendment. Board voted unanimously on initial vote.

TOWN MANAGER'S REPORT

Town Manager presented his report as is referenced on the attached.

Upon motion by Selectman McKinnon and seconded by Selectman Dalpe, Board voted unanimously to authorize the Chairman, or his designee, to sign a letter to the state legislators asking for support in changing MGLc 94C and 105 CMR 700.003 to include ambulance services to be able to resupply first responders with Narcan.

Re: Fernway Estates - Roadway Layout Recommendation


Honorable Board:
