

RE: Improvements to 20 Centre Street Town Office Entranceway

Last fall our Office had allocated Community Development Block grant funds to make minor repairs to sidewalks on Centre Street and to make improvements to the area outside of the 20 Centre Street Town office – removing shrubbery, shoring up sidewalk edging, and installing brick wall/planter, etc. The total budgeted for this work was \$18,800. The amount allocated from this for 20 Centre Street entranceway improvements was about \$9,000. At that time we did obtain design options and quotes for work but then winter set in and we were not able to begin work on the project. Now we are prepared to move forward.

In regard to the entranceway improvements there are two options that are being considered:

Option 1:

Brick wall with planters, with or without signage (refer to attached). The wall would be appropriate height to attach a railing for support of pedestrians. To achieve this, the wall would be two levels and at the highest point would be 48 inches higher than the outside curb (if a railing was not needed than the highest point would be around 42 inches at highest point).

The Middleborough Disabilities Commission has expressed that they would minimally like one railing and support Option 1 or 2. The Historical Commission discussed this in their May 5th meeting and is indicating a preference for Option 2. The Commission previously favored a brick wall/planter but are concerned about the wall height (did not want this to exceed 2 ½ to 3 ½ feet in height) and how a railing would fit in with this wall/planter.




Option 2:

No brick wall/planter. Brick pavers will be in place of current shrubbery and new granite curbing would extend above this. A decorative wrought railing that would fit in with historic buildings would be installed the length of the sidewalk/ramp (40 feet). This would serve as a railing for pedestrians. Large urns would be installed where shrubbery is currently or window boxes (wrought iron) will be placed along the railing facing the street side. Attached is rough sketch with railing and a dimensional drawing.


We would like to engage a contractor to begin work in May and appreciate direction from the Board.

(WITH OR WITHOUT SIGNAGE)




