

RE: Request to post sign in the parking lot at the Town Hall & Town Employee Parking Lot behind Benny's


The Middleborough Animal Control and Health Departments are launching an educational program aimed at preventing pets from overheating in cars during the warmer weather. Eight signs were purchased and donated by Oak Point Management and an additional donation from Oak Paws Club for signs to be displayed at several locations around Middleborough. These signs will help educate and deter people from leaving pets in cars during warm/hot months. On an eighty-five degree day, temperatures in a car can reach one-hundred and two degrees in ten minutes even with the windows cracked! Along with the signs, educational flyers will be available at the locations where the signs will be placed for the public. This is a request to post an educational sign in parking lot of the Town Hall as well as the parking lot behind Benny's. The Town Hall Lawn is used for various functions and placing a sign in the parking lot will be visible to many residents who frequent this location.
